

RESOLUTION NO. 97-431

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL
APPLICATION FOR CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT FUNDS
ON DATE OF JUL 29 1997

WHEREAS, the Congress under Public Law 89-665 has authorized the Establishment of a National Historic Preservation Grants-in-Aid Program providing matching funds to the State of California and its eligible subdivisions for historic preservation context, survey, registration, training; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation is responsible for the administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application under the program; and

WHEREAS, said adopted procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications and the availability of local matching funds prior to submission of said application to the State;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sacramento City Council;

1. Approves the filing of an application for the National Historic Preservation Grants-in-Aid assistance for a Historic Preservation Plan/General Plan Element project; and
2. Appoints the City Manager or his/her authorized deputy as the agent to coordinate, process, and execute all contracts, agreements, amendments and ancillary documents within the scope of the attached application.
3. Agrees that all required local matching funds will be provided for the project.
