

ORDINANCE NO. 973, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 822, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED APRIL 28, 1939, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE STORAGE AND/OR INSTALLATION OF PLANTS AND AUTOMOBILE FILLING STATIONS, HANDLING AND/OR DEALING IN THE LIQUIFIED PETROLEUM GAS KNOWN AS BUTANE; DESIGNATING INFLAMMABLE LIQUID TRANSPORT TRUCK ROUTES; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE," BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO TO BE NUMBERED $4\frac{1}{2}$.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 822, Fourth Series, passed April 28, 1939, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be numbered $4\frac{1}{2}$.

Section $4\frac{1}{2}$. During the national emergency caused by the present war with Germany, et al, the City Council may grant temporary permits limited to such emergency for such installations at places other than prescribed in Section 4, upon certificates of the Building Inspector and Chief of the Fire Department that unusual public danger will not be caused thereby.
