

ORDINANCE NO. 1534, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE ELECTRICAL SUPPLIES AND HAVE CERTAIN ELECTRICAL WORK DONE AT THE SACRAMENTO PUBLIC LIBRARY BY CITY FORCES WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase certain electrical supplies in the open market and also to have certain electrical work done by City forces in the Sacramento Public Library, consisting of electrical work for the improvement of the second floor lighting system. Such supplies to be purchased and work to be performed without first advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251, of the City Charter. The estimated cost for the completion of the work is \$3,200.00.



SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of making improvements in the lighting system of the second floor of the Sacramento Public Library for the complete use and enjoyment of the citizens of the City.
