

ORDINANCE NO. 1617, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE CERTAIN CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS AND HAVE THE CONSTRUCTION WORK OF BUILDING REST ROOM FACILITIES AT THE BING MALONEY GOLF COURSE DONE BY CITY FORCES WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase certain plumbing, building, and painting materials for the construction of rest room facilities at the Bing Maloney Golf Course, and to have this work done by city forces without first advertising for bids pursuant to Section 251 of the City Charter. The estimated cost of this work is \$2,500. That said sum is hereby appropriated out of the Golf Fund to complete said work and the City Controller is hereby authorized to expend said sum for the construction and completion of the work.


SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of the construction of rest room facilities at the Bing Maloney Golf Course so that said buildings may be completed prior to the opening of said golf course.
