SUBJECT: Request for Resolution authorizing an increase in the Library's budget by \$66,200; the amount received from a grant under the Library Services and Construction Act

SUMMARY

In April 1981, the Library was awarded a grant of \$66,200, by the California State Library under the Library Services and Construction Act, (LSCA) for a pilot program for individuals 13 to 18 years of age, to promote literacy and reading in cooperation with local schools and other community agencies.

BACKGROUND

The purpose of this pilot program at the Martin Luther King, Jr. Regional Library is to create a non-judgmental environment that will encourage youths ages 13 to 18 to seek answers to their informational needs and encourage recreational reading.

The project will include the students at local junior and senior high schools, (Charles Goethe, John Still, St. Anne's, Sacramento Christian Schools, Luther Burbank and John F. Kennedy), with close cooperation and interaction with the schools, public service agencies and community groups dealing with this target area. The Library would establish and maintain a separate area within the Martin Luther King, Jr. Regional Library especially designed for this group. The youths, themselves, will participate in the decision-making processes of the project through a Youth Advisory Committee, under the direction of a Project Coordinator.

FUNDING

Approval and award of the grant to the Library provides for administration of funds by the City of Sacramento as Fiscal Agent. There is no obligation on the part of the City of Sacramento to participate in the program monetarily.

RECOMMENDATION

It is therefore recommended that your Council approve the attached resolution authorizing an increase in the Library budget of \$66,200.
