## CITY HOMELAND SECURITY INITIATIVES

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

WHEREAS, On November 25, 2002, President Bush signed into law the "Homeland Security Act of 2002" creating a Federal Cabinet-level Department of Homeland Security, Border and Transportation Security

WHEREAS, There will be financial and technical resources that will become available to develop and strengthen America's level of knowledge and expertise in Emergency Preparedness and Response, Chemical, Biological, Radiological and Nuclear Countermeasures, and Information Analysis and Infrastructure Protection; and


WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of California has indicated his plan to encourage the growth of the state's biotechnology industry to meet the needs of Homeland Security and to make California "America's arsenal for Homeland Security"; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento City Council will collaborate with other regional and state-wide stakeholders on behalf of these proposals.


THEFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Sacramento has identified as a priority initiative the establishment and promotion of the Greater Sacramento Region as a Regional Center for Pacific Rim/Western United States Homeland Security research, training and logistical activities,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Sacramento will participate in a Homeland Security Task Force comprised of economic development agencies in the region, in an effort to position Sacramento as the Homeland Security Center of the Western United States.
