SUBJECT: Status Update of the City's Waste Disposal Projects

### SUMMARY

This report provides the Transportation and Community Development Committee with the current status of the City's Waste Disposal Projects.

### DISCUSSION

#### 1. SMUD WASTE-TO-ENERGY CO-GENERATION FACILITY

Mr. Solon Wisham, Jr., the Assistant City Manager, provided the joint Budget & Finance and Transportation & Community Development Committees with the most recent SMUD co-generation facility proposal on February 13, 1985.

#### 2. PRIVATELY FUNDED WASTE-TO-ENERGY FACILITY

Privately funded Waste-To-Energy responses are being held in abeyance pending City Council Committee's negotiations with SMUD.

#### 3. LANDFILL COMPLIANCE

At a February 7, 1985 meeting the Chief Executive Officer of the California Waste Management Board, Mr. George Eowan, informed his Board that the Sacramento City Landfill had complied with the Board's 30-day intensive inspection requirements.

#### 4. LANDFILL EXPANSION

Construction of the expansion to the City's landfill continues on schedule with minimum inclement weather interference.

5. RIVER PARK CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON LANDFILL EXPANSION


City Staff has held two (2) meetings with the River Park Advisory Committee. The most recent of these meetings was held on the evening of February 13, 1985. Topics discussed at this meeting were:

- a. Current results of the odor assessment study.
- b. Current results of the accoustical consultant's studies (final analysis has been delayed by rain).
- c. An explanation of the landfill's clay liner, its purpose, its design, its construction and installation inspection.
- d. An explanation of the landfill berm's construction.
- e. Planning of a River Park City Advisory Committee tour of the the existing and expansion landfills.


RECOMMENDATION

This item is for information only and no action is required by the Transportation and Community Development Committee.


