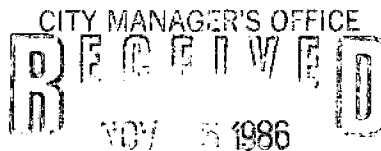

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

On September 30, 1986, the City Council approved plans and specifications for the construction of the City Landfill Security Fence. The bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on October 28, 1986. Ten (10) bids were received and are as follows:

The estimated construction cost was \$26,400.00


FINANCIAL DATA
