RESOLUTION APPROVING PETITIONS

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON

DECEMBER 16TH, 1971

WHEREAS, petitions have been filed with the City Council requesting that proceedings be adopted for the construction of Portland Cement Pavement with Drainage Facilities, together with all necessary appurtenances in the Alley in the Block between S and T Streets, from the Easterly line of 24th St to the Westerly Line of 25th Street.



WHEREAS, the signers of said petitions state that they are all of the Owners of more than 60% of the area liable for Assessment for said work and improvement, and they expressly "WAIVE" the provisions of Division 4 of the "Streets and Highways Code of the State of California" (The Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931), as amended, and all investigations, proceedings and reports provided for therein; and

WHEREAS, the said petitions have been checked by the City Engineer's Office and found that the WAIVER is signed by the Owners of more than 60% of the area liable for Assessment for said work.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council that the said petitions are hereby approved and granted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby finds and determines that the WAIVER in said petitions is signed by the Owners of more than 60% of the area liable for said work and improvement and hereby directs that proceedings for said work be authorized, as provided in Division 7 of the said Streets and Highways Code, THE IMPROVEMENT ACT OF 1911.
