RESOLUTION No. 361

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

August 20, 1970

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA is hereby granted a revocable permit to use unused City property for the purpose of constructing planters.

The property is more particularly described as follows:

The area between the back of the sidewalk and the property line on the north side of E Street from the westerly line of 29th Street to a point 121.20 feet westerly therefrom and the westerly side of 29th Street from the northerly line of E Street to a point 160.65 feet northerly therefrom.

This permit is granted with the following conditions:

- 1. Permittee shall determine the location of and protect and support all utilities in the public rights of way and shall bear the entire cost of any necessary relocation or reconstruction made necessary by reason of settlement or damage to utilities.
- 2. That permittee shall protect and save the City of Sacramento harmless from all damages, costs and causes of action in connection with the granting of this permit.
- 3. If this permit is revoked for any reason, permittee agrees to reconstruct the planter areas on its own property at its own expense in accordance with the standards then required, if planter areas are required under the laws of the City of Sacramento at the time of the revocation of this permit.
- 4. The provisions of this permit shall apply to and be hinding upon the permittee, its successors and assigns, and permittee agrees not to transfer its property without notifying the transferee of the provisions and obligations of this permit. The permittee further agrees to indemnify the City for any costs incurred by the City in installing the necessary planter improvements in the event permittee does not inform transferee of the provisions of this permit.
