

## RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0234

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

June 11, 2019

### Reimbursement from Sprint for Radio-Banding Project

#### BACKGROUND

- A. As part of a nationwide federal initiative to reduce radio interference to public safety communications, the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) has ordered the 800MHz radio frequency be re-band/reprogrammed to protect public safety communications, (the “project”).
- B. On May 15, 2007, the City adopted a resolution (2007-270) to establish a Radio Re-Banding Project AB96 (later renamed A07000100) and authorize the City to accept external funding in the amount of \$667,331 from Sprint to reimburse the City for the estimated costs of its efforts to reduce radio interference to public safety communications, and executed an Inter-Governmental Agreement with the County of Sacramento for the County to coordinate project planning on behalf of cities under the County of Sacramento and Sprint’s administrative representative.
- C. The initial project estimate was \$667,331. Sprint reconciled this estimate with the City’s efforts and revised the estimate to \$958,900. Sprint advanced half of the revised project estimate (\$479,450) to the City to begin work on the project with the understanding that the project would be trued-up at the completion of the work. In July 2011, the City completed the work. On December 24, 2018, Sprint issued an additional reimbursement payment to the City in the amount of \$479,499 for a total amount of \$958,900. In January of 2019, Sprint issued closing documents to close the project. On April 23, 2019, the Transition Administrator for the project reviewed, approved the closing documents, and closed the project.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager’s designee is authorized to accept reimbursement payments from Nextel West Corp. (“Sprint”) for an additional amount of \$291,569 for the City’s Radio Re-Banding Project (A07000100).
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager’s designee is authorized to adjust the revenue and expenditure budgets in the Radio Re-Banding Project (A07000100) by \$291,569 in Fund 3702 (CIP Reimbursable Fund).
