**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA DIRECTING THE CITY
ATTORNEY TO PREPARE AN IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS**

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election is to be held on November 2, 2004, at which there will be submitted to the voters a measure pertaining to a parcel tax for additional library services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

Section 1: That the City Council directs the City Clerk to transmit a copy of the measure called to the November 2, 2004 ballot to the City Attorney. The City Attorney shall prepare an impartial analysis of the measures showing the effect of the measure on existing law and the operation of the measure. The impartial analysis shall not exceed 500 words and shall be filed by the date set by the City Clerk for the filing of primary arguments.

Section 2: That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
