RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL CANCELLING
COUPON NO. 1 ON \$130,000.00, PRINCIPAL AMOUNT
OF CITY OF SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT
BONDS--YEAR 1936 (ALARM AND SIGNAL SYSTEM).

WHEREAS, The City Council, by Ordinance No. 681, 4th Series, has heretofore authorized the issuance of bonds in the principal amount of \$130,000.00 with coupons payable July 1 and January 1 of each year, consisting of all the bonds of Series "D" as designated in said Ordinance No. 681, 4th Series (Alarm and Signal System), and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Resolution No. 426 of the City Council, the City Treasurer was authorized and directed to sell said bonds, and

WHEREAS, the sale of said bonds was made on October 7 1936, which date is later than the maturity date of Coupon No. 1 on said bonds and thereby rendering same ineffective,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That Coupon No. 1 on each of said bonds be removed and cancelled and that the City Treasurer be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to remove and cancel same before said bonds are delivered to the purchasers thereof.
