BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute for and on behalf of the City of Sacramento Fire Department, the named applicant, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California, any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining federal assistance under the State Homeland Security Grant Program and accept the grant funding in the amount of \$684,183.
