

RESOLUTION NO. 4257

VACATING PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENTS
PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 50430 TO 50445,
INCLUSIVE OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF
THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, a petition in accordance with Sections 50430 to 50445, of the Government Code of the State of California has heretofore been filed with the City Council of the City of Sacramento requesting vacation of the public utility easement hereinafter described; and


WHEREAS, said public utility easement is described as:

The Southerly 3.00 feet of Lot 2, as the same is shown on the official plat of Showler Terrace, Reserving Therefrom, the Easterly 3.00 feet of said Lot 2.

Whereas, the date of dedication of the hereinbefore described public utility easement is less than five years and more than one year, and the public utility easement was not used continuously since that date, and that said public utility easement is not now used or occupied nor has it at any time been used or occupied for the purpose for which said public utility easement was dedicated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Council does hereby find and declare that all of the facts, as above set forth in this Resolution, are true and correct; That by reason of the findings and premises aforesaid, said public utility easement, as above set forth and described, has not been used since November 1, 1966, or at all, and is unnecessary for present or prospective use, and therefore, is hereby declared abandoned and vacated.
