SUBJECT: Expand Scope of Project - Curtis Park Running Track (LD66)

### SUMMARY

This report provides information regarding the Curtis Park Running Track CIP project and requests authorization to expand the scope of the project to include restroom renovation and site work.

No additional City funds are requested.

#### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Development of a one mile running track around the perimeter of this 18.57 acre community park was included in the FY 1987-88 City Capital Budget. This project includes construction of a decomposed-granite running track over an already existing pedestrian trail. Funds for the development of the track were provided by a 1986 Park Bond Act grant for \$112,000.

A fund balance of approximately \$53,776 remains in this project and must be expended and the project completed by June 30, 1990. Staff recommends that the scope of this project by expanded to include the renovation of the restrooms: a project which can be completed by June 30, 1990. Grant sources have approved this project expansion.

#### FINANCIAL DATA

The Curtis Park Running Track project (LD66) currently has a fund balance of \$53,766 in Capital Grant funds. Cost of renovating the restrooms at Curtis Park is estimated at approximately \$53,776. No additional City funds are equested.
