SUBJECT: MODIFICATION OF PARKING TIME LIMITS ON A PORTION OF N STREET IN THE STOCKTON/ALHAMBRA BOULEVARD RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

N Street from Alhambra Boulevard to 32nd Street. Council District 3.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council approved the attached resolution modifying the parking time limits on a portion of N Street from one hour except with permit to no parking except with permit.

SUMMARY:

The residents along N Street between Alhambra Boulevard and 32nd Street (Exhibit A) have petitioned to change the existing one hour permit parking time limit to prohibit all parking except with permit. Prohibiting all parking on this street will relieve the parking congestion generated by U.C.D. Medical Clinic employees and patients. The proposed parking regulation change will make it easier for residents to park near their homes.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The Alhambra/Stockton Boulevard residential permit parking area was established in April 1992.
- Parking congestion has continued to be a problem across from the U. C. D. Medical Clinic.
- Area residents have requested to change the existing one hour parking time limit to no parking.
- The residents, that will be impacted by this change, were sent a letter which outlined the request and solicited comment.
- There is no opposition to the proposed change.
- The medical clinic has adequate off street parking for employees and patients.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation change is estimated to be \$200 for the modification of the existing regulatory signs. Funds are available in the Street Division, Traffic Signs and Markings, operating budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301 of the CEQA Guidelines.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:





**A RESOLUTION MODIFYING PARKING REGULATIONS WITHIN THE
ALHAMBRA/STOCKTON BOULEVARD RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA**

WHEREAS, On-street parking regulations within a residential permit parking area may be changed by resolution of the City Council based on recommendation by the parking manager.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

The on-street parking regulations in the Alhambra/Stockton Boulevard residential permit parking area shall be regulated as follows:

Modify the one hour parking, except with permit, from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., except Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays, to No parking, except with permit, from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. except Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays on the following street segment:

- N Street, south side, from 3114 N Street to 3170 N Street.

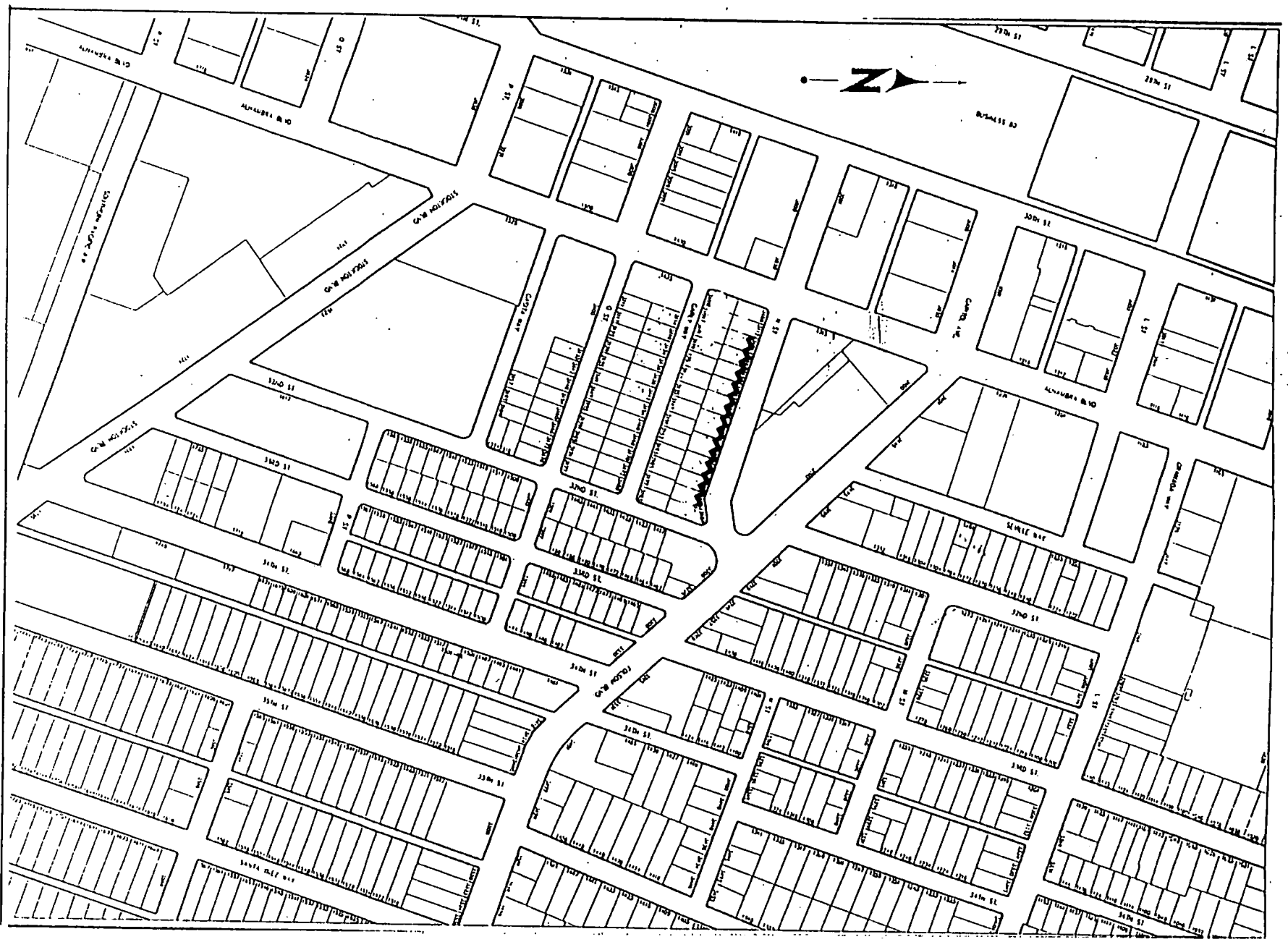
