

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 3691

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, public interest and convenience require the abandonment and vacating of the Street hereinafter described.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sacramento hereby declares its intention to abandon and vacate the following described Street:


All that portion of Marin Avenue lying between the East line of 79th Street, produced, and the Westerly line of West Railroad Avenue produced, as said Streets are shown on the official plats of "Brighton Addition", "Sequoia Park" and "Bonnie-mead Tract"; RESERVING HOWEVER, the Right of Entry to repair, maintain and construct sewer, water and gas pipes, and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities now in place in said street, or which from time to time may be placed therein. This abandonment is made upon the condition that no structures shall be built or placed upon said right of way reserved. All proceedings in connection with the aforesaid abandonment are to be taken subject to such reservations and exceptions.

Said Street is shown on a Plat on file in the office of the Clerk of the City Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the 10th day of October, 1963, at the hour of 7:45 o'clock P. M., in the Council Chamber of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, on I Street between 9th and 10th Streets, in said City, be, and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for the hearing of the proposed abandonment of said Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk be directed to publish Notice Of Hearing of the proposed abandonment of said Street in the Sacramento Union, a daily newspaper, as required by law, and that said Notice be posted along said Street to be abandoned, in accordance with the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, Sections 8300 to 8324, Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.
