



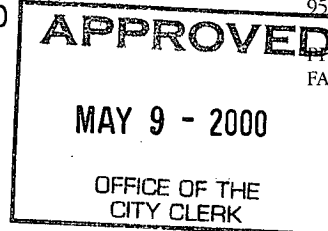

**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION TO PROHIBIT PARKING ALONG THE CUL-DE-SAC ON  
ACADEMY WAY**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Cul-de-sac on Academy Way facing north onto Del Paso Boulevard. Council District 2.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution prohibiting all parking along the cul-de-sac on Academy Way.

**SUMMARY:**

This report recommends parking be prohibited along the cul-de-sac of Academy Way at all times (Exhibit A). This area is being used for older model cars being offered for sale by their owners. This is creating an unnecessary increase of traffic on this road which has otherwise a low-traffic flow. Prohibiting parking in this area will eliminate vehicles being offered for sale, reduce the traffic flow and reduce the number of non residents.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- Vehicles are being parked to be sold by owners and is causing an unnecessary increase in traffic into the residential area.
- Residents on Academy Way submitted a letter of request to have all on-street parking prohibited along the cul-de-sac at the end of Academy Way.
- A letter was sent to all residents outlining the proposal to restrict parking along the cul-de-sac.
- There was no opposition to the proposal.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$500 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the On-street Parking & Animal Care Services operating budget.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement.



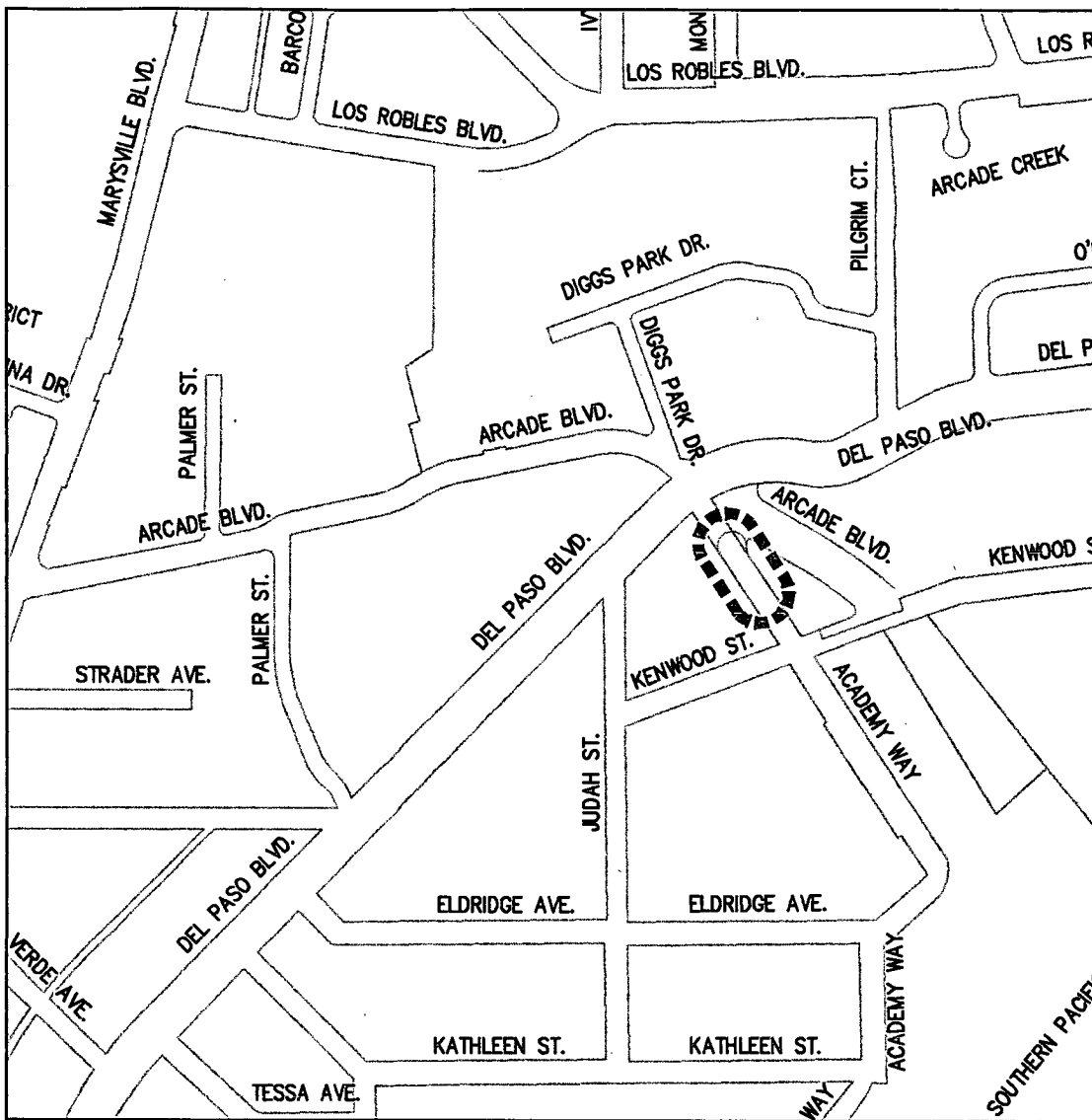

**RESOLUTION PROHIBITING ALL PARKING

All parking shall be prohibited at all times on the following street:
