WHEREAS, D.A.R.T. members risk their lives whenever entering the dark fast rivers, all in effort to return individuals to their loved ones; and


WHEREAS, D.A.R.T. members are self trained and self taught, and will continue to be an entricle part of the emergency response teams within the City of Sacramento.






