Mr. Wright expressed the opinion that living costs during the past two or three months have dropped considerably and appear to have leveled off, as shown by the Bureau of Labor Statistics Index during the past year. Mr. Wright also stated that there appears to be no doubt that inequities exist in the salary plan as shown in the report, particularly in some classifications in which a

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a large number of city workers are employed, which would have been eliminated if a two step increase had been granted on July 1, 1952, instead of a one step increase.

After general discussion by members of the Board, the Secretary was directed to arrange a joint meeting with the Civil Service Committee of the City Council for the purpose of discussing said report.
