SUMMARY

This report regards the proposed use hearing for General Revenue Sharing funds for the 1981/82 fiscal year in accordance with Regulation 51.13(a) of the Revenue Sharing Act of 1972.

BACKGROUND

The proposed use hearing is intended to provide citizens with the opportunity to make oral and written comments regarding possible uses of General Revenue Sharing funds. The amounts of funds are \$5,548,000 for fiscal year 1981/82 and \$918,000 unappropriated in 1980/81, for a total of \$6,466,000. This hearing is being held seven days prior to submission of the 1981/82 Preliminary Budget to the Budget and Finance Committee for consideration.

A public notice regarding this hearing was published for 10 days in the Daily Recorder beginning Tuesday, March 31, 1981. In addition the public notice was sent to general community organizations, organizations serving senior citizens, local newspapers, television, and radio stations. A copy of the public notice is attached.

A subsequent public hearing will be held regarding the City's proposed uses of General Revenue Sharing at the time the City Council considers approval of the 1981/82 Preliminary Budget in June 1981.

RECOMMENDATION

The staff recommends the City Council receive written and/or oral comments concerning the possible uses of General Revenue Sharing, close the public hearing,

and transmit any received comments to the Budget and Finance Committee for review in consideration of the 1981/82 Preliminary Budget.
