Recognizing Councilmember Robbie Waters

WHEREAS, Councilmember Robbie Waters, along with other elected officials and local chambers representatives, attended the annual Capital to Capital trip in April 1999; and

WHEREAS, during this trip, while attending a reception for the United States Senate and House of Representatives and staff, Councilmember Robbie Waters was instrumental in saving a choking man's life; and

WHEREAS, Dr. John Young, a local physician and husband of Sacramento City Unified School Board Member Karen Young, was choking and silently signaling for help when Councilmember Robbie Waters rushed up and performed the Heimlich maneuver dislodging the obstruction; and

WHEREAS, while it is unknown if Dr. Young would have died had he not been rescued, it should be noted that Councilmember Robbie Waters through attention and knowledge of appropriate procedures in a life-threatening situation, saved the life of Dr. Young.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby commend Councilmember Robbie Waters for this heroic deed.
