PRESCRIBING PROCEDURE FOR REMOVAL OF STREET TREES

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has in the possession of her many aged and beautiful shade trees, an asset of incalculable benefit to the resident and visitor,

WHEREAS, the rule established by the preceding Council requiring that body to express itself with reference to the removal of any shade tree on a public street has accomplished considerable in preventing the removal of many trees; and

WHEREAS, there exists the necessity of a formal procedure to be followed by the City Council with reference to the removal of trees on public thoroughfares,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as a measure of cooperation with the administrative officials of the City, that the following rules be established as the procedure under which the Park Superintendent through the City Manager is requested to act on the removal of any tree on a public street; viz,

1. Whenever the Park Superintendent after a full investigation deems necessary the removal of any street tree, he is hereby requested through the City Manager to refer the application for such removal together with a detailed report thereon to the City Council for an expression as to their approval or disapproval.

2. Whenever any such application is so filed a public hearing thereof shall be set before the City Council at its next regular meeting thereafter.

3. After foregoing hearing has been duly set and held the City Council may then by an affirmative vote of five of its members express the sense of the Council in favor of or against the removal of the tree, and

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Council hereby requests the Park Superintendent, whenever a permit for the removal of a tree or trees is granted by him, conditioned upon the planting of a tree or trees in the place of the tree or trees so to be removed, that he require a bond from the permittee to secure the performance of the condition relative to the said replanting.




