BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE
CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The budget is hereby amended to reflect the conversion of the existing position of Project Manager in the Redevelopment Division, to Project Manager, Old Sacramento/ Agency Architect, to add an Associate Planner in the Redevelopment Division, to add an additional Project Manager position in the Redevelopment Division, to delete a Property Rehabilitation Specialist II position in the Rehabilitation Division, and to delete an Administrative Assistant I position in the Redevelopment Division.




Section 3. The job classification of Project Manager, Old Sacramento/Agency Architect is hereby established. The monthly salary range for this classification shall be:



EMPLOYEES


WHEREAS, the salaries and benefits payable to unrepresented
