

RESOLUTION NO. 95-004

ADOPTED BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO

ON DATE OF MAY 16 1995

POLICE-IN-RESIDENCE PROGRAM

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1: The Executive Director is authorized to establish the Police-in-Residence Program ("Program") which allows the Housing Authority to rent not more than six public housing units located in the targeted low-income neighborhoods of Del Paso Heights, Strawberry Manor, Oak Park, Avondale/Glen Elder, Meadowview, and Woodbine to sworn police officers for \$1 per month, subject to the following provisions.

Section 2: To be eligible to participate in the Program, individuals must be sworn officers in the City of Sacramento Police Department who have successfully completed their one-year probationary period, are not currently living in the areas targeted in the Program as described in Section 1 of this resolution, and have filed their interest in the Program with the Housing Authority of the City of Sacramento.

Section 3: Police Officers eligible for the Program shall be given an option, for 48-hours, to rent any public housing unit which becomes available within said targeted neighborhoods, and such units shall be rented to the first responding eligible officer.

Section 4: Program participants shall enter into a standard lease agreement with the Housing Authority and shall be subject to all conditions and requirements placed on Housing Authority residents.

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Section 5: During the second full year of the Program or when six public housing units have been rented to eligible police officers, Housing Authority staff will return to the Housing Authority of the City of Sacramento with an evaluation of the Program and recommendations regarding the potential to expand the Program.
