**SUBJECT: ARDEN GARDEN CONNECTOR PROJECT, PHASE 2 (PN:TA87) -  
APPROVAL OF REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH SMUD IN THE  
AMOUNT OF \$132,373.**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Arden Way and its westerly extension between Del Paso Boulevard; and Garden Highway westerly of Northgate Boulevard. Districts 1 and 2.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends the City Council:

- Approve the Reimbursement Agreement with SMUD in the amount of \$132,373 for the relocation of existing electrical facilities.

**SUMMARY:**

This report requests the City Council approve the utility relocation reimbursement agreement with SMUD in the amount of \$132,373 for the removal and undergrounding of overhead electrical facilities along Arden Way, between Colfax Street and Northgate Boulevard.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

None.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Construction of the final phase of the Arden Garden Connector project is under way. The project requires the relocation and undergrounding of several overhead electrical facilities which are in conflict with the proposed improvements. The agreement will reimburse SMUD for the installation of new conductors through conduits constructed along the Arden Garden project, and for performing the necessary connections to existing facilities. The new conductors will replace existing facilities which have been temporarily relocated to allow for the construction of the City's project. The amount of the reimbursement agreement is \$132,373.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The project cost is \$21,533,000. Funding is being provided from a variety of City, Federal and State programs. As of April 2, 1999, \$2,329,846 remained unobligated in the project account which is sufficient to cover the cost of this reimbursement agreement.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The project Environmental Impact Report was certified by the City Council on June 18, 1996. A Record of Decision for the Federal Environmental Impact Statement was issued on December 30, 1996.


