**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE AMERICAN RIVER PARKWAY PLAN UPDATE  
PROCESS DESIGN AND APPROVE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE UPDATE  
CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:**

**The City Council hereby:**

1. Approves the American River Parkway Plan Update process and accepts the Final Convening Report.
2. Establishes the Update Citizens' Advisory Committee. There is hereby established the City/County Update Citizens' Advisory Committee for the American River Parkway Plan.
3. Approves the Purpose of the Committee. The Committee is established for developing advisory recommendations to the Sacramento City Council and Sacramento County Board of Supervisors for updating the 1985 American River Parkway Plan.
4. Approves the Duties of the Committee Members. The Committee's primary duties shall be the following:
  - a. Work collaboratively to develop advisory recommendations, taking into account laws and policies governing the Parkway, community values and need, scientific and technical information about the Parkway's resources, and concerns raised by staff of public agencies.
  - b. Attend all regularly scheduled meetings having reviewed previous meeting summaries and background materials distributed in advance of each meeting.
  - c. Participate in community workshops and consider public comments and concerns in deliberations.

- d. Work toward agreement by making good faith efforts to understand differing points of view and attempt to find solutions acceptable to all Committee members and the Technical Team.
  - e. Provide effective representation by consulting their organizations or geographic area constituents on upcoming issues and informing them about Update Committee deliberations.
5. Appointment of Committee Members.
- a. The Committee will consist of twenty-five (25) members as described in Exhibit B and attached to this resolution. Four (4) of these members will be appointed by the City Council.
  - b. The four (4) members to be appointed by the Sacramento City Council shall be active in civic, business, and/or neighborhood organizations in their areas.
  - c. The length of term served by each Committee member is a 36-month period beginning at the first meeting of the Committee.
  - d. The sunset date of the Committee will be 36-months after the first meeting of the Committee.
  - e. The Sacramento City Council and Board of Supervisors shall hold the first meeting within 28 days of the appointment of all members.
  - f. Subsequent meeting of the Committee shall be every four to eight weeks.
  - g. Committee members shall serve without compensation.
6. Definition of Geographical Areas Represented by City of Sacramento appointments:
- a. North Sacramento: The area as defined by the North Sacramento Planning Area 8.
  - b. Natomas: The area as defined by the South Natomas Planning Area 9.
  - c. Central City: The area as defined by the Central City Planning Area 1.
  - d. East Sacramento/College Green: The area as defined by the East Sacramento Planning Area 6.

#### **One Individual Representing the County of Sacramento's Recreation and Parks Commission in an ex-officio capacity (1)**

As the entity responsible for the operation and management of the American River Parkway, the County's Recreation and Parks Commission will assign one of its members to serve on the Update Citizens Advisory Committee in an ex-officio capacity.

#### **Individuals Representing Geographic Areas (10)**

Individuals who are active in civic, business and/or neighborhood organizations in their areas will be appointed as Geographic Area Representatives by either the Board of Supervisors, Sacramento City Council or Rancho Cordova City Council through the open recruitment process of each jurisdiction.

1. **City of Sacramento** appoints 4 (one seat for each adjacent area: North Sacramento, Natomas, Richards Boulevard/Downtown, and Midtown).
2. **Sacramento County Board of Supervisors** appoints 5 (One seat for each supervisorial district).
3. **City of Rancho Cordova** appoints 1.

**Geographical Definition for City of Sacramento Appointments:**

1. North Sacramento: The area as defined by the North Sacramento Planning Area 8.
2. Natomas: The area as defined by the South Natomas Planning Area 9.
3. Richards Boulevard/Downtown: The area as defined by the Central City Planning Area 1.
4. Midtown: The area as defined by the East Sacramento Planning Area 6.
