

ORDINANCE NO. 1454, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE TWO (2) FOUR DOOR SEDAN TYPE AUTOMOBILES IN THE OPEN MARKET WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase in the open market, without advertising for bids, pursuant to Section 251 of the City Charter, TWO (2) FOUR DOOR SEDAN TYPE AUTOMOBILES, for use by the Police Department.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of the City of Sacramento to acquire immediately said automotive equipment to fulfill the City's needs.
