**SUBJECT:** Resolution Appropriating Funds and Recommendation of Bid Award for Resurfacing of City Streets

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as a part of the City's Capital Improvement Program for F.Y. 1982-83, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends bid award.

BACKGROUND:

On July 27, 1982, the City Council approved plans and specifications for Resurfacing of City Streets in seven locations and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on August 17, 1982. Bids received are as follows:

Granite Construction	362,417.60

It is proposed that the funding for this project be approved prior to approval of the F.Y. 1982-83 Capital Improvement Program for that reason.




