SUBJECT: Relocation of Cardroom License

SUMMARY

Application has been filed by Mrs. Geraldine Smith requesting relocation of her license from "Bostons", 4214 Stockton Blvd., Sacramento, Ca. to 800 El Camino Avenue, Sacramento, Ca.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The building at 800 El Camino Avenue located at the corner of El Camino Avenue, Beaumont Street and Del Paso Boulevard is zoned C-2 with adequate parking on the site. The Planning Department has no objection to approval of this application.

Investigation and a report from the Chief of Police indicates that he has no objection to the relocation.

An on-site inspection was conducted by the Fire Marshal and Building Inspectors and both approved the facility.

Mrs. Smith has been a holder of a cardroom permit since the death of her husband.

Sacramento City Code, Chapter 5 - Amusements - Article I, Cardrooms - sets forth the following conditions:

Section 5.3-10 (Application for Cardroom License Under Certain Circumstances)

"Notwithstanding the prohibitions contained in this article against the issuance or transfer of a cardroom license, an application by a cardroom licensee for a change of location or an application by a person in interest to a license for the issuance of a license in his own name to operate the same business as the former licensee may be made to the City Council, in the following manner."


