

ORDINANCE NO. 1552, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING  
A CERTAIN UNNAMED ROAD AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE  
AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That certain unnamed road situate in the  
City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California,  
described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North line of Parcel No. 1 described in the decree quieting title entered October 19, 1933, in the Superior Court of Sacramento County in an action entitled Harry L. Huston, executor of the Last Will and Testament of Ella T. Merkley, deceased, vs. William K. Weston, et al., Suit No. 42485, Decree No. 28251, recorded October 21, 1933, in Book 450 of Official Records of Sacramento County, at page 89, which point bears South 28° 22' West 1916.40 feet from an iron pipe at the intersection of the center line of 5th Street with the center line of Y Street, now Broadway; thence from said point of beginning, South 8° 52' West 557.30 feet; thence South 2° 48' East 558.16 feet to a point on the Southerly line of said Parcel No. 1; thence along said line, North 76° 02' West 41.78 feet to the West line of a 40 foot strip; thence North 2° 48' West 550.20 feet; thence North 8° 52' East 565.10 feet to a point on the North line of said Parcel No. 1; thence along said line South 75° 50' East 40.17 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.022 acres, more or less.

The foregoing being all that certain tract or strip of land conveyed in Grant Deed dated October 8, 1907, from E. T. Merkley to Southern Pacific Company, recorded October 28, 1907, in Book 261 of Deeds, at page 338, Sacramento County Records,

is hereby declared closed, abandoned and vacated.

Said closing and vacating is declared after due proceedings had therefor according to law.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be

an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that the property known as the Merkley Property, within which this unnamed road is located, is proposed to be sold to the Sacramento Housing Authority for the installation of new housing projects, and that it is necessary that this road be closed immediately to complete this transaction without delay.
