

RESOLUTION No. 100

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

JUN 21 1945

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

The following rates are payable to the City of Sacramento for the use of the Sacramento Municipal Auditorium are hereby fixed and established:

1. For either a day or night performance or use, for boxing or wrestling, a minimum charge of \$100.00 where the gross receipts of each performance or exhibition given during said day does not exceed the sum of \$1000.00, and in addition to the above there shall be payable 5% of the gross receipts in excess of \$1000.00 for each performance given during any one day, with a maximum price of \$500.00 payable for any one performance during either day or night.

"GROSS RECEIPTS", as used herein, shall mean gross receipts of all performances given, less State and Federal Tax.

2. All other types of use, performance or exhibition, a minimum charge of \$150.00 shall be payable where the gross receipts of any one performance, either day or night, does not exceed the sum of \$1500.00, and in addition to the above there shall be payable 5% of the gross receipts in excess of \$1500.00 for each performance given during any one day or night, with a maximum price of \$500.00 payable for any performance either day or night.

If no admission is charged by any of the users, the minimum charges above set forth shall apply for each type of performance or use as above set forth.

It is further provided, however, that one-half of the foregoing prices shall be payable in case of use sponsored by and held solely and exclusively under the auspices of local patriotic bodies for the benefit of ex-service men or women.

3. Little Theatre:

Day.....	\$ 15.00
Night.....	25.00
Day and Night.....	30.00

4. Memorial Hall:

Day.....	10.00
Night.....	15.00
Day and Night.....	20.00

5. In lieu of above rates the Superintendent may arrange with the lessees for compensation on a percentage basis, subject to the approval of the City Manager.

6. For any use not above specified a charge may be fixed by the Superintendent, subject to the approval of the City Manager.

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7. Reservation may be assured by deposit of \$25.00 on date of reservation; and Superintendent is authorized to require balance to be paid in advance on the day of performance before doors are opened. When rental is on a percentage basis, the Superintendent shall estimate the advance rental to be required.

Cancellation of dates with less than three weeks notice to the Auditorium Superintendent shall constitute a breach of contract and forfeiture of the \$25.00 shall be made.

8. For use of any units of the auditorium over an extended period of time a special rate may be fixed by the Superintendent, to be approved by the City Manager; but no lease shall be made which would tend to give a monopoly of any unit to any organization or individual, or tend to prevent the general use of any of the units of the auditorium.

9. For the use of the main auditorium with stage and committee rooms for New Year's Eve, a rate of \$300.00 shall be charged; provided that said Auditorium shall not be rented if the City is using the same for the evening; provided further that this rate shall not apply to any fraternal or benefit organization or society for their sole and exclusive use.

Note: Additional charge of \$25.00 per hour if the use runs past 1:00 A.M.

10. The Superintendent shall have the authority with the sanction of the City Manager to refuse the use of the Auditorium or any part thereof to any lessee where such use would be contrary to sound public policy.

11. That the use of the Memorial Hall shall be free of cost to patriotic organizations for regular meetings, which uses shall be arranged so that same shall not interfere with paid rentals, on a schedule of dates to be arranged by the Superintendent.

12. Every person or organization using the Memorial Auditorium for the purposes set forth herein, shall provide such number of guards or special officers as may be deemed necessary by the Superintendent, approved by the City Manager, for the purpose of maintaining order at all times.

13. In the event of loss or damage to the Memorial Auditorium, or any property situate therein, the Superintendent shall determine said loss or damage within one (1) week following such affair and shall give the rentor a statement in writing of the extent of such loss or damage; the amount then shall be due and payable to the City of Sacramento.

Failure to make prompt settlement of such loss or damage shall constitute a breach of good faith and the rentor shall be denied further use of the Memorial Auditorium until such settlement be made in full.

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14. That any duly organized and recognized veterans organization shall be entitled to use the Sacramento Memorial Auditorium one time during each year without being required to pay the regular rental fee for the Memorial Auditorium, provided that notice is given at least thirty days in advance of the time selected for such use, and that the time so selected shall not conflict with reservations previously made for the use of said Auditorium.

15. All prior resolutions relating to the establishment of rates for the rental of the Municipal Auditorium are hereby superseded and repealed.
