

ORDINANCE NO. 2067, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING ALL THAT PORTION OF THE ALLEY LYING FIRST NORTHERLY OF MARSHALL WAY FROM THE WESTERLY LINE OF 32ND STREET TO THE EASTERLY RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF THE SOUTH SACRAMENTO FREEWAY, AS DESIGNATED IN DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, 1953 SURVEY FROM 2 MILES SOUTH OF FLORIN ROAD TO 30TH AND U STREETS, IN SACRAMENTO, ROAD III-SAC-4-SAC., IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: All that portion of the Alley lying first Northerly of Marshall Way from the Westerly line of 32nd Street to the Easterly Right of Way line of the South Sacramento Freeway, as designated in Department of Public Works, 1953 Survey from 2 miles South of Florin Road to 30th and U Streets, in Sacramento, Road III-Sac-4-Sac., in the City of Sacramento, is hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.

RESERVING, however, the right of entry to repair, maintain and construct sewer, water and gas pipes and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities, now in place in said Alley or which from time to time may be placed therein.

Said closing and vacating is declared after due proceedings had therefor, according to law and a finding by the City Council, which is hereby made, that said portion of said Alley herein described is unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk shall publish this ordinance once within 10 days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
