

ORDINANCE NO. 1511, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE TWO (2) TRACTOR DRAWN, HYDRAULICALLY OPERATED, GANG MOWERS IN THE OPEN MARKET WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase in the open market, without advertising for bids, pursuant to Section 251 of the City Charter, TWO (2) TRACTOR DRAWN, HYDRAULICALLY OPERATED, GANG MOWERS, for use by the Recreation Department, to replace similar equipment destroyed in the fire at the Corporation Yard.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the immediate use of said mowers by the Recreation Department for the cutting of grass on the golf courses and other grass cutting needs of the City.
