## National Letter Carriers Food Drive Day May 13, 2000

**WHEREAS**, many individuals in the City of Sacramento do not have sufficient food to sustain themselves and in many cases their families; and


**WHEREAS**, in recognition of this hunger need, the National Association of Letter Carriers (NALC) and the Camellia Branch Letter Carriers Local 133 AFL-CIO have conducted a *Letter Carrier's Food Drive* in the City of Sacramento for the past seven years; and

**WHEREAS**, this year, the NALC, the United States Postal Service, and United Way California Capital Region will be sponsoring the "2000 NALC National Food Drive" on May 13, 2000 and will be asking residents and businesses to donate nonperishable food items for the needy by leaving their donations by their mailboxes; and


