

Sacramento, California,
July 11, 1929.

The Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento met in special session on the above date in their office, Room 106 City Hall, President Chenu presiding.

PRESENT: Commissioners Weisman and Chenu.
ABSENT : Commissioner Mason.

The minutes of the previous meeting of July 5, 1929, were read and approved as read.

The Board then proceeded with the Personal Fitness Test for Sanitary Inspector. Nine candidates were interviewed for this classification. Upon motion by Commissioner Weisman, seconded by Commissioner Chenu, and unanimously carried, the following eligible list, posted July 12th and effective July 15th, 1929, was established:

The Board next considered the case of Owen Orr now employed as Watchman (River Patrolman). The pay roll bearing the name of Owen Orr and disapproved by the Secretary was presented to the Board for their opinion. Upon motion by Commissioner Weisman, seconded by Commissioner Chenu, and unanimously carried, the Secretary was directed to call the attention of the City Manager to the pay roll submitted by the Engineering Department. The Secretary was instructed to advise the Manager that ~~since a classification now exists for Watchman that such position should be filled from the Watchmen's eligible list.~~ *egs*
