

ORDINANCE NO. 2028, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 936, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED OCTOBER 17, 1941, RELATING TO THE DEFINITION OF "CITY ELECTRICIAN."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Section 101 of Article 1, Part I of Ordinance No. 936, Fourth Series, passed October 17, 1941, which defines "City Electrician" in the following words:

"City Electrician: The person under the supervision of the City Engineer, in charge of enforcement of all the provisions of this ordinance and all other ordinances, laws, lawful orders, rules and regulations that are now, or may hereafter be in effect, with respect to the installation and performance of electrical work. He also has charge of, and is responsible for, the maintenance and efficient operation of the fire alarm, traffic and police signal systems and all electric light, power and communication systems, or equipment now owned or hereafter constructed or acquired by the City of Sacramento."

is hereby amended to read as follows:


"City Electrician: The person under the supervision of the City Engineer, in charge of enforcement of all the provisions of this ordinance and all other ordinances, laws, lawful orders, rules and regulations that are now, or may hereafter be in effect, with respect to the installation and performance of electrical work."

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be published once in the official newspaper of the City of Sacramento and shall take effect thirty (30) days from and after its passage.
