**ADOPTING THE SACRAMENTO COUNTY
MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

Whereas, City of Sacramento recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

Whereas, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

Whereas, an adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

Whereas, City of Sacramento fully participated in the FEMA-prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Whereas, the California Office of Emergency Services and FEMA, Region IX officials have reviewed the "*Sacramento County, California Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan*" (December, 2004) and approved it (March 21, 2005) contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governments and entities;

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the City of Sacramento adopts the "*Sacramento County, California Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan*" as an official plan.
