

Resolution of Award No. 2476

2476

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the 20th day of February, 1942, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned;

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To **A. Teichert & Son, Inc.,**

at the prices specified in its proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of **8th Avenue**, from the westerly boundary of "Altamont Tract" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California), to the pavement in place approximately 15 feet west of the westerly line of 56th Street,

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. 2476, passed and adopted by said City Council on January 16, 1942, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement, and of the district to be assessed for the costs and expenses of said work.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the "Sacramento Union," a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.
