

# RESOLUTION NO. 2004-127


ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL

ON DATE OF FEB 24 2004

**EMERGENCY VEHICLE PRE-EMPTION PILOT PROJECT (PN: SL56 – FUND 201/209) – ESTABLISH CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; APPROPRIATE FUNDS; ACCEPT BID; EXECUTE CONTRACT; SUSPEND COMPETITIVE BIDDING; DIRECT STAFF ON MEASURE A REALLOCATION REQUEST; AND DIRECT STAFF TO RETURN TO COUNCIL**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:**

1. The Emergency Vehicle Pre-Emption Pilot Project (PN: SL56) be established as a new Capital Improvement Project;
2. The FY 03/04 Capital Improvement Program is amended by appropriating \$385,000 from Measure A Construction Contingency (Fund 201-held by STA) and \$250,000 from Major Street Construction Contingency (Fund 209) to the Emergency Vehicle Pre-Emption Pilot Project (PN: SL56);
3. The low bid of Tim Paxin's Pacific Excavation, Inc. in the amount of \$319,987 be accepted for the Emergency Vehicle Pre-Emption Pilot Project (PN: SL56);
4. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute a contract with Tim Paxin's Pacific Excavation in the amount of \$319,987 for installation of the Opticom equipment on the selected routes;
5. In the best interests of the City, competitive bidding is suspended for the purchase of emergency vehicle pre-emption equipment and this equipment purchase is sole sourced directly to 3M Opticom in the amount of \$245,261 for the Emergency Vehicle Pre-Emption Pilot Project (PN: SL56);
6. Staff is directed to bring a Measure A reallocation request in the amount of \$385,000 to the Sacramento Transportation Authority (STA) Board for approval; and
7. Staff is directed to return to Council after a six-month test period to commence upon completion of the pilot project installation.
