Req. Work Permit

Application to accept part-time
employment filed by Francis Cox,
Stage Electrician, Memorial Auditorium,

was considered.

Mr. Francis Cox personally appeared before the Board with reference to his application, stating that a considerable amount of time is devoted to stagehand work with road shows in addition to employment setting up and taking down the boxing and wrestling ring and conducting the Sacramento Theatrical Lighting Company which deals in electrical advertising and renting of electrical equipment in the Memorial Auditorium.

SUPERINTENDENT BLDG. MAINTENANCE
SUPERVISOR AUTOMOTIVE MAINTENANCE

Communication from the City Engineer with reference to the reorganization of the Building Maintenance and Auto-

motive Maintenance activities at the City Corporation Yard, recommending that a new position of Superintendent of the Building Maintenance Division and Supervisor of Automotive Maintenance be created, was considered.

After reviewing the duties of said proposed positions, Mr. Deise moved that the Board recommend to the City Council that the position of Building Maintenance Division Superintendent at Salary Range No. 36, \$500-\$600 per month and Automotive Maintenance Supervisor at Salary Range No. 34, \$460-\$550 per month be created; seconded by Mr. Marty and motion carried.
