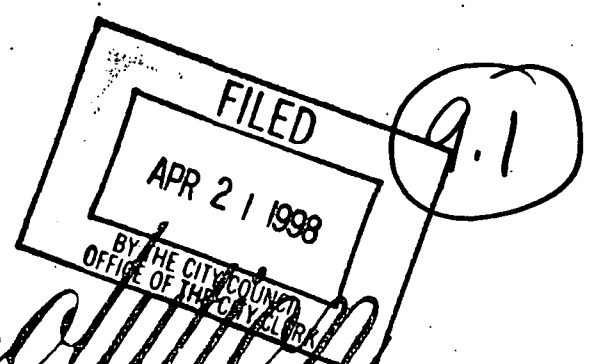


Resolution
