

RESOLUTION No. 1042

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

RESOLUTION EXTENDING SCOPE OF DOCKET CALIF.
1981-F (SEWER SYSTEM EXTENSIONS).

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento desires to broaden the scope of the project to include a tapered diffusion outfall pipe in the bed of the Sacramento River for the purpose of disposing of sewage by dilution and to modernize the equipment now installed in the old portion of the building to meet modern safety standards, and to do painting and miscellaneous work, and this additional work will require 221 calendar days, necessitating an extension of the docket from the date of its expiration - November 22 1939 - to June 30 1940, and

WHEREAS, the work covered by this amendatory application consists of the following:

1. Tapered diffusion outlay pipe with gate and supporting piling.
2. Protective equipment for motors Nos. 1 to 8, inclusive.
3. Safety type dead front panel board.
4. General illumination and switch board lighting in old building.
5. Switch for new power panel in new motor room.
6. Vacuum pump magnetic switch and control circuits.
7. Guard rails around four screen pits.
8. Water lines for screen washing.
9. New door bumper.
10. New sewer screen.
11. Portable sump pump.
12. Painting the interior and exterior of building.
13. Painting motors, pumps and valves in old portion of building.
14. Minor improvements to outfall sewers gate works.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the work hereinabove set forth be included in the scope of Docket Calif. 1981-F (Sewer System Extensions) at the estimated cost of approximately \$40,000.00

Resolution No. 1024, passed November 10 1939, is hereby superseded.
