

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0284**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

### **Approving the Application and Execution of Grant Agreement for Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Program Grant Funds for Cabrillo Park & Pool Project**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The State Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility by the Legislature of the State of California for the administration of the Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Grant Program and set up necessary procedures governing grant applications and grant awards.
- B. Procedures governing the application as established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of the application and if successful, authorization to execute the grant agreement with the State of California to implement the project in accordance with the scope set forth in the grant application.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. Approves the filing of a grant application for the Cabrillo Park & Pool Improvement Project for an amount up to \$2,097,818.
- Section 2. The City certifies that it has or will have available, prior to commencement of any work on the project included in the application, sufficient funds to complete the project.
- Section 3. The City certifies that if the grant is awarded for the project, it has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project.
- Section 4. The City certifies that it has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the State contract included in the Grant Administration Guide.

- Section 5. The City delegates the authority to the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, to conduct all negotiations, and sign and submit all documents, including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the project in accordance with the Grant Scope.
- Section 6. The City certifies that it agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and guidelines related to acceptance of the grant funds for the project.
- Section 7. The City will consider promoting inclusion per Public Resources Code §80001(b)(8 A-G).
