### SUSANVILLE WASTE -TO-ENERGY FACILITY

Tour at 9:30 a.m.

This is the State's first operational waste-to-energy cogeneration facility.

**Location:** Lassen Community College, Highway 139, Susanville, California *That's the only address.*

**First Date Of Operation:** The Plant is scheduled to be fully operational by October 1, 1984.

**Quantity of Solid Waste Utilized Per Day:** 100 tons of municipal solid waste & wood chips.

**Energy Generated:** 1.5 megawatts of electrical power, and 34,000,000 BTU's/hour for space heating.

**Project Cost:** \$7.1 million. Private financing for the facility was arranged by Bankers Leasing Corporation. The college owns the land and leases the facility.

**Revenues:** The energy produced is being utilized as steam heat for the College. Extra energy is being sold to Pacific Gas & Electric Company.

**Project Manager:** Carson Development Company

### SUSANVILLE TRIP: TENTATIVE ITINERARY

**Dates:** Thursday, October 25 and Friday, October 26

**Distance:** 252 Miles - Approximately 4-5 hours driving time.

**Schedule:** 10/25 Noon - Leave Sacramento  
Spend the night in Susanville

10/26 Morning - 2 hour tour of the waste-to-energy facility  
Noon - Leave Susanville  
6:00 p.m. - Arrive in Sacramento

**Transportation:** Rented bus with seating capacity for 43 persons.  
Total Cost - \$1,000. The cost for the bus will be shared equally by all riders.  
Reservations for space on the bus will be taken on a first come-first served basis.
