

ORDINANCE NO. m 965 , FOURTH SERIES


AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE A CARLOAD OF ALUMINUM SULPHATE WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE, TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase in open market, without first advertising for bids a carload of aluminum sulphate at an approximate cost of \$1,000.00, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that, due to the present National Emergency, the United States Government will not permit the City to use the supply of Bauxite it has on hand and it is necessary to use aluminum sulphate to purify the domestic water supply for the city and it is necessary that this purchase be immediately made in order to protect the drinking water supplied to the city.
