

Resolution of Intention No. 2547

Pursuant to a law of the State of California, known as Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code, the Improvement Act of 1911."

It is hereby resolved that it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Sacramento to order the following street work to be done, to-wit:

The improvement of the following in the City of Sacramento:

C STREET from the center line of 51st Street to the westerly line of Elvas Avenue; AILEEN WAY from the easterly line of Lagomarsino Way to the westerly line of Elvas Avenue; D STREET from the easterly line of Lagomarsino Way to the westerly line of Elvas Avenue; E STREET from the easterly line of Lagomarsino Way to the westerly line of Elvas Avenue; F STREET from the northerly projection of the westerly boundary of Monterey Terrace (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), to the southerly projection of the center line of Elvas Avenue; EASTERLY ONE-HALF OF 51ST STREET from the westerly projection of the northerly boundary of East Sacramento Terrace/ (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), to the northerly line of C Street; LAGOMARSINO WAY from the northerly boundary of said East Sacramento Terrace Unit No. 2 to the northerly line of F Street; 54TH STREET from the southerly line of E Street to the northerly line of F Street; 55TH STREET from the southerly line of E Street to the northerly line of F Street; ELVAS AVENUE from the easterly projection of the northerly line of said East Sacramento Terrace Unit No. 2 to the northerly line of F Street; by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; grading and constructing concrete curbs, gutters and sidewalks; constructing concrete manholes complete with cast iron curbs and covers; re-constructing existing manholes by placing curbs and covers to proper grade; grading and constructing vitrified ironstone pipe sewers; placing cast iron gutter drains and connecting same to sewer system with vitrified ironstone sewer pipe; installing street monuments; grading and constructing an asphaltic concrete pavement; placing Oregon Pine Header Boards where shown on plan; installing one inch water service taps, where shown on plan

IMPROVING RIGHT-OF-WAYS owned by the City of Sacramento in the rear of Lots 1 to 54 inclusive; Lots 66 to 91 inclusive, all in East Sacramento Terrace, (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), and IMPROVING RIGHT-OF-WAYS owned by the City of Sacramento along the line common to Lot 62 and 63 of said East Sacramento Terrace; and IMPROVING RIGHT-OF-WAYS owned by the City of Sacramento in the rear of Lots 1 to 38 inclusive in said East Sacramento Terrace Unit No. 2; and IMPROVING RIGHT-OF-WAYS owned by the City of Sacramento along the westerly line of Lot 38 of said EAST SACRAMENTO TERRACE UNIT NO. 2; by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; constructing concrete manholes complete with cast iron curbs and covers; grading and constructing vitrified ironstone pipe sewers; placing Flusher Branches as shown on Plans; and

IMPROVING THE ALLEY lying 1st westerly of Elvas Avenue and the ALLEY 1st northerly of F Street as shown by dedication on the Map of said East Sacramento Terrace; by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; constructing concrete manholes complete with cast iron curbs and covers; grading and constructing vitrified ironstone pipe sewers.

All of said work shall be done in accordance with the detailed plans therefor adopted by the City Council and now on file in the office of the City Engineer, and also in accordance with the "Standard Specifications for the Improvement of Streets and Alleys and for the Construction of Sewers" heretofore adopted by the said City Council.

Cast iron gutter drains shall be as shown on Cut No. 11 of said Specifications.

Concrete curbs and gutters shall conform to Cut No. 6 and Cut No. 13 of said Specifications, where, and as shown on the detailed plans for said improvement.

Manhole covers shall be as shown on Cut #1B of said Specifications.
 Sewer Joints shall be made with G-K Sewer Joint Compound as specified in Section 13 of said Specifications.
 Flusher Branches shall be as shown on Cut #15 of said Specifications.
 One inch water service taps shall be installed in accordance with Specifications of the Water Department of the City of Sacramento and Section 16 of the said "Standard Specifications."
 Asphaltic Concrete Pavement shall be as shown in Section 29 of said Specifications, and

WHEREAS, said City Council has found and determined that pursuant to Section 2804 of Division 4 of the Streets and Highways Code, of the State of California, the owners of more than 85% of the area of the property subject to assessment for the above described improvement, have signed and filed with the City Clerk, a written petition, and said owners did in said petition WAIVE the proceedings required by the "Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931", and the said City Council does hereby approve of said WAIVER and resolves to commence proceedings as provided in Division 7 of the "Streets and Highways Code", "The Improvement Act of 1911."

And whereas, in the opinion of said City Council said work is of more than local and ordinary public benefit, said Council hereby orders that the costs and expenses of said work and improvement shall be chargeable and charged upon a district of lands, which district is hereby declared to be the district benefited by said work and improvement and which is to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof.

The exterior boundaries of said district and the extent of the territory included therein are shown upon the map of said district adopted and approved by the City Council on May 17, 1946, which map is now on file in the office of the City Engineer and to which reference is hereby made for a particular description of the boundaries of said district and of the extent of the territory included therein;

Saving and excepting from the above bounden and described district the area of all public streets, alleys, ways, boulevards, courts and avenues included therein.

Notice is hereby given that serial bonds to represent unpaid assessments and bear interest at the rate of four (4%) per cent per annum will be issued hereunder in the manner provided by the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," the last installment of which bonds shall mature fourteen (14) years from the second day of July next succeeding ten (10) months from their date.

All persons objecting to said work, or to the extent of said assessment district, are required to file their objections in writing in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Sacramento, as required by law, and notice is hereby given to all persons interested that on the 7th day of June 1946, at eight o'clock p. m., in the Council Chamber of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, in the City Hall, on "I" Street, between 9th and 10th Streets, in said City, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work and improvement may appear before said City Council and show cause why the proposed work and improvement shall not be carried out in accordance with this Resolution.

And the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution twice in the Sacramento Union, a daily newspaper, as required by law.
