

ORDINANCE NO. 1442, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING, AND ABANDONING A PORTION OF THE ALLEY FIRST NORTH OF McCLATCHY WAY AND LYING ALONG THE NORTHERLY BOUNDARY OF RIVERSIDE TERRACE, FROM THE EASTERLY LINE OF LOT 135 OF SAID RIVERSIDE TERRACE, PRODUCED NORTHERLY, TO THE WESTERLY LINE OF LOT 128 OF SAID RIVERSIDE TERRACE, PRODUCED NORTHERLY, IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1: That a portion of the alley first North of McClatchy Way and lying along the Northerly boundary of Riverside Terrace (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder) from the Easterly line of Lot 135 of said Riverside Terrace, produced Northerly to the Westerly line of Lot 128 of said Riverside Terrace, produced Northerly, in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, is hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.


RESERVING, however, the right of entry to repair, maintain and construct sewer, water pipe, gas pipe and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities now in place in said alley, or which, from time to time, may be necessary to be placed therein.

Said closing and vacating is declared after due proceedings had therefor, according to law and a finding by the City Council, which is hereby made, that said portion of said alley herein described is unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes.
