

ORDINANCE NO. 1456 FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 19 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1344, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JANUARY 23, 1948, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AND PROVIDING RULES FOR THE DETERMINATION THEREOF, REPEALING ORDINANCES NOS. 1297, 1301, 1307, 1317, 1325, 1332, 1335 and 1337, RESPECTIVELY OF THE FOURTH SERIES, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT FEBRUARY 1, 1948" AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:
